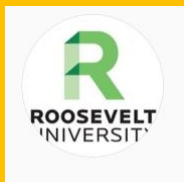

OSR Podcast

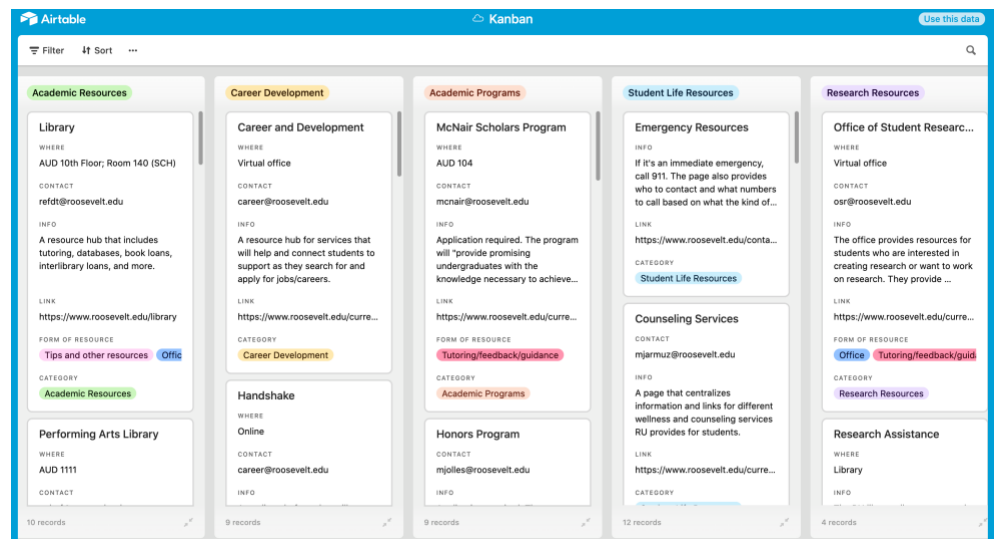
